

GlassTrend Seminar on Emission from glass furnaces.

Haarlem (NL), 25 & 26 April, 2017

GlassTrend is organising a seminar on flue gas emission from glass furnaces on April 25 & 26, 2017. The objective of this meeting is to bring together experts from the glass industry to exchange information in the field of gaseous and dust emissions. The current and future requirements imposed by international environment regulatory bodies will be addressed too. Some experts from the Technical Committee TC13 of ICG will also participate and give presentations. The topics to be addressed will include: REACH regulations, measuring techniques and modelling tools to assess evaporation and emissions, primary measures to reduce NO_x, evaporation and dust emissions and secondary measures for emission abatement.

The target group consists of GlassTrend members and invited TC13 members. Registration is limited to about 80 persons. Each GlassTrend member company may send 2 persons to the seminar free of charge. Invited members of the ICG-Technical Committee TC13 will also have free access. Venue of the meeting is the Stadsschouwburg & Philharmonie in the city of Haarlem (NL).
